Adult Education Teaching Credential

The Full-time Adult Teaching Credential authorizes the holder to teach the subjects named on the credential in courses organized primarily for adults.

To obtain the **preliminary credential, valid for five years**, you must:

- Verify 5 years of work experience and/or education related to each subject to be named on the credential
- Have one of the following:
 - ◇ High school diploma
 - ◇ GED diploma
 - ◇ Foreign equivalent of a high school diploma
- Pass the California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST)
- Complete U.S. Constitution course or pass an exam on the U.S. Constitution
- Obtain verification, signed by a Commission-accredited Local Education Agency (LEA)

Career Technical Education Credential

The Career Technical Education Credential authorizes the holder to teach the subjects named on the credential in grades k-12 and in classes organized primarily for adults in career technical instruction courses.

To obtain a **preliminary credential, valid for 5 years**, you must:

- Verify 5 years of work experience related to each subject to be named on the credential.
- Within the last 3 years, have at least 1 year of related work experience or a total of 1,500 hours of any combination of the following:
 - ◇ Related work experience
 - ◇ College level related course work
 - ◇ Non-college related course work
 - ◇ Occupational internship
 - ◇ Vocational teaching experience
- Have one of the following:
 - ◇ High school diploma
 - ◇ GED diploma
 - ◇ Foreign equivalent of a high school diploma
- Complete U.S. Constitution course or pass an exam on the U.S. Constitution
- Obtain verification from a Local Education Agency (LEA) or an Employing School District
