√	Performance Step(s)	Comment(s)
	Take BSI precautions.	
	Apply direct pressure to the wound.	<i>Expose injured area.</i>
	Elevate the injury to above the level of the heart.	
	Apply pressure dressing to the wound.	
	Apply firm pressure to the arterial pulse proximal to the injury site.	
	Bandage the dressing in place with roller gauze, cravats, or elastic bandages.	<i>Assess distal circulation to ensure bandage was not applied too tightly.</i>
	Position the patient properly, and begin transport.	
	Treat for shock if needed.	
NOTE: The patient is in compensatory shock.		
	Properly position the patient.	
	Maintain the airway and apply high concentration oxygen.	
	Elevate the supine patient's legs above chest level.	
	Prevent heat loss.	<i>Cover with a blanket.</i>
	Monitor the patient.
