	Take BSI precautions.	
	Perform a Scene Size-Up.	
	Assess for spinal protection.	
	Perform an Initial Assessment.	
	Administer high concentration of oxygen, if necessary.	
	Manage problems associated with the airway, breathing and circulation.	
	Differentiate the patient's need for transportation versus continued assessment at the scene.	
	If the mechanism of injury was significant, perform a Rapid Trauma Assessment.	
	If there is no significant mechanism of injury perform a Focused History and Physical Exam of the affected body system or area.	<i>This includes inspection and palpation of the isolated area of complaint.</i>
	Obtain baseline vital signs.	<i>This includes pulse, respirations and blood pressure.</i>
	Gather the past medical history using SAMPLE.	
	Perform a Detailed Physical Exam.	
	Manage secondary injuries and wounds appropriately.	
	Perform Ongoing Assessment.
