I. Contract update

The negotiating team sought a three year agreement, but settled on a one-year agreement because of extensive re-openers requested by the District. The now-ratified one-year agreement includes no salary or benefit increases or reductions but is subject to re-openers in to salary, shift differential, professional growth, parking, longevity, classification study, and health benefits in each quarter with 30 days notice from the district.

Brad noted that the new college administration may employ a different philosophy than the previous one, as it lacks the institutional knowledge of its predecessor. He also noted that the District did not receive deferred payments promised from the State and may have to begin using its reserves next month.

II. Leah: Benefits update

Leah was absent. There was no benefits report. Leah will send an informational e-mail to membership when she is able.

III. Janus: State of Board (of Trustee's); PAC information

Janus noted that two board seats will be open for election in November. Claudine Wildman holds the seat representing Scott's Valley and is stepping down. Donna Ziel is running against Robert Tosto for the Scott's Valley seat, while incumbent Al Smith will be opposed by local business owner Martin Avila in the Aptos/Watsonville area. Candidate forums and endorsements will come soon. Janus thanked Kim Flock, Raneta Pomeroy, Terri Cesari, Kim Flock, and Fran Guerrera for their work on the PAC committee and requested PAC donations from members.
