If the District notifies CCEU, they can potentially call CCEU back to the table in January for re-openers. However, health benefits may be negotiated with CCFT prior to the CCEU re-openers in January. The Negotiations Team and Board of Directors will meet to discuss the possibility of negotiating benefits only, so that decisions regarding these matters do not go forward without CCEU's ability to participate.

Item 5.) PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Janus will be out on medical leave for an extended period of time, which overlaps Stephanie's absence by a few weeks. Janus assured membership that others will capably take her place.

Alta updated members about the Board's plan to lead CCEU in Steph's and Janus's absence. She assured members that the Board of Directors will continue to meet regularly.
