Independent Living Skills Instructor-Fall 2008 (Stroke Center)

The Stroke and Disability Center seeks an Independent Living Skills Instructor in Ceramics/Art for a substitute pool beginning spring 2008. Pending funding, there may be an opening for 2-5 TU as academic specialist in fall 2008. This position requires small group instruction in Ceramics and Creative Expression for adults with physical disabilities and /or neurological deficits. Must have Masters degree in category of disability or Art Therapy or special education or rehabilitation or equivalent. Occupational Therapy License desirable.

A copy of your Occupational Therapy License must be submitted with your application materials if applicable.

Mobility Instructor-Fall 2008 (Stroke Center)

This semester replacement for 4.5 TU is for 10.8 hours per week as academic specialist. Position requires small group instruction in Mobility for adults with physical disabilities and/or neurological deficits. Must have Masters Degree in category of disability or special education or rehabilitation or equivalent AND current physical therapy license.

A copy of your Physical Therapy License must be submitted with your application materials.

State Minimum Qualifications-Nursing:

Associate degree in nursing plus six years clinical experience **OR**
The equivalent. ***Please see equivalency information below.***

Equivalency Requirements

Equivalency to an academic degree shall include the same depth of knowledge in the discipline and breadth of general education that is required for the degree to meet the minimum qualifications. Equivalent preparation for employment shall be considered under any one category or any combination of the categories listed below:

- a) Degree in related field with equivalent course work in the required discipline as indicated by transcripts and/or thesis subject.
- b) Equivalent degrees from foreign universities (as determined by an agency selected by Cabrillo College).
- c) Course work at an accredited institution of higher education **AND** state-approved continuing education units applicable for maintaining licensure **AND/OR** an internship for licensure **AND/OR** equivalent professional or work experience **AND/OR** equivalent verifiable accomplishments of eminence in the discipline including but not limited to: publications, research, seminars, creative works, professional performances or exhibitions, honors or awards.
