OLD BUSINESS:

A. Vote to endorse CALPRIG

Standing Tall- wants to know if an event might be planned where people with disabilities may participate.

Bike CO-OP: Wants to make the event as environmentally friendly as possible.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Bus problems: Over Crowded, Under Scheduled Busses w/ Routes to and from Cabrillo.

Standing Tall- Believes ICC funding should address more real issues rather than sponsor more parties and cultural events.

- Want a resolution from ICC to make an effort to do something about the shortage of busses issue.

- Taking a survey and having a bus spokesman come speak.

- Wants \$300 from ICC, and that then to be matched by others such as the senate and Cabrillo College.

- Thinks money should be allocated to promote benefits to the student body.

GAMES- Believes this is not an issue for ICC to be dealing with. Discussions should deal with ICC issues only.

- Believes Standing Tall should take the issue to the senate.
