Sustainability:

-Does not believe there is an adequate amount of club awareness on campus.

- Suggests possibly making another club board to advertise for clubs
- Online site would spread awareness well
- Possible advertisement in *The Voice*

LLN:

- Suggests making a banner to advertise all of the clubs
- Suggests possibly advertising in the school newspaper/magazine
- Believes welcome week should be held during the first week

Permaculture:

- Suggests putting a club board in the gymnasium
- Agrees with standing tall that welcome week should be held the second week of the spring semester.

Outdoor Club:

- Suggest assigning a member from each club to be in charge of advertising and updating club boards.

Standing Tall:

- Noticed that all of the clubs are not advertised on the club board in the cafeteria.
- Believes it would be too difficult and unorganized to hold welcome week the first week of the semester.

Flor: Wants everyone to know they are responsible for their own advertising.

- If you bring flyers to Flor, then they will be posted on the club boards
- All advertisements need to be up to date.
- Everyone needs to be prepared for the first ICC meeting of Spring 2011 semester .
