OLD BUSINESS:

Sustainability: Believes there should be a better way for the ICC to communicate with the student body.

CCC: Believes that a welcome week event should be held at a different time of the year when students are not so pre-occupied like the beginning the year.

Democrats: Also agrees there should be another club awareness day. Possibly during the upcoming ICC gladiator event.

Bike Co-Op: Suggests putting something on Web-Ct.

LLN: Suggest possibly sending out a large e-mail or petitioning to have an article written in the voice.

Standing Tall: Suggests making a large banner with the machine available which would advertise all of the clubs on campus.

Dig It: If you hold an event, use the supplies available to advertise your club.

AGS: Believes there is room for both individual clubs and the ICC as a whole to advertise clubs actively.

Bike Co-Op: Believes ICC should suggests that students start there own clubs if they have a particular interest they feel passionate about.

D. The role of the Senate funds to the ICC

\$25,000 allocated for just incentives

\$8000 additional dollars allocated to divide amongst the clubs.

-ICC members are required to be part of the process of amending by laws.

-Senate states that all clubs may not receive the \$1000 they had originally intended to distribute.

SAP: Notices a trend in ICC and the Senate separating when the ICC is supposed to be working in conjunction with the Student Senate.

- Believes we should force the Senate to review our by laws.

Standing Tall: Wants clarification on the issue of being a Senator as well as being an ICC club member.

LLN moves to extend time

Time Extended

Flor: Agrees that the senate needs to be reminded of their responsibilities stated in the bylaws.

Sustainability: Would be in favor of the bylaws being amended to approve the funding if a multicultural event is to be held.

SAP: Believes the situation is black and white and no amendment needs to be made, rather the Senate simply needs to be reminded of their duties to the ICC.

CCC: Where does the Student Senate get the funds to allocate funds to the ICC?
-Comes from the fees students pay when they enroll in school as well as from other presentation fees.

GAMES: Suggest separating Incentives and Activities accounts.

SAP: Clarifies that they are currently separated.

LLN: Needs clarification on funding requests procedures.

Standing Tall: Wants the issue to be included on the next agenda.

E. Agenda Items, Time limits, and Votes

Standing Tall: Does not believe there should be a time limit on items being discussed and items to which action is being taken.

GAMES: Clarifies that some students have class after meetings and others have responsibilities to attend to.

CCC: Agrees with GAMES
