

## **Big changes to repeatability coming to students very soon!!!**

---

The **STATE MANDATED** change will make it impossible for a student to enroll in courses more than 3 times if the student has withdrawn or received a substandard grade (D, F, NP or NC.) This change is **RETROACTIVE**. Cabrillo College has until SUMMER 2012 to implement this change.

### **How does it work?**

---

Beginning in **SUMMER 2012**, any student who has withdrawn from any course after census (the beginning of the 3rd week for a full term course or after 20% of the course for short term courses) OR has gotten a substandard grade OR any combination of the above for three (3) attempts will be unable to enroll in that course a 4th time.

*It is very important that during the spring 2012 semester you complete, with a passing grade, any course you might need for transfer or you need to complete degree objective if this is your 3rd try for the course.*

***If you are confused about this important change, please see a Cabrillo Counselor when figuring out your SPRING 2012 Schedule!***

**Example:** Jane Any-Student took ENGL 1A three times. She dropped it in the 6th week once and she got a "D" grade and a "NP" grade. Will she be able to take the class in the spring 2012 semester? Yes, she can enroll in spring 2012 (on a space available basis). ***However, starting summer 2012, she will no longer be eligible to enroll in ENGL 1A!***
