

## **Cooperative Work Experience Education**

Cooperative Work Experience Education (CWEE) provides students with college credit for on-the-job experience that meets the learning objectives developed with a Work Experience Instructor (WEI) and a job supervisor. One unit of credit is earned for 60 hours of unpaid work or 75 hours of paid work. Students may take up to 4 credit units.

**CWEE199G** (non-transferable) General Work Experience Education/Service Learning

For students who want to explore career opportunities this program combines classroom instruction with paid or volunteer work experience utilizing the community's business, industry, government, and non-profit agencies as expanded educational sites. Service Learning, a form of General Work Experience Education, is for students who are co-enrolled in a course that is offered in a Service Learning format.

**CWEE99G** (transferable) General Work Experience Education/Service Learning

For students who want to explore career opportunities and who want to transfer the credit to a CSU. Work Experience credit is limited at some CSU campuses - check with a counselor.

### **Career Work Experience**

For students enrolled in career oriented majors this program provides work experience directly related to the student's career major. Students who enroll in Career Work Experience must be concurrently enrolled in one other course that qualifies for the degree or certificate in their career major.
