Cabrillo College will double count these courses in Area 4 for purposes of Certification. For CSU, PS courses must include a section on California government. Out of state students who have taken a US Political Science course may take a one-unit supplement on California government at the transfer CSU. For UC, a student may complete this requirement in High School. Please check with a counselor.

NOTE: Each course used for IGETC to fulfill Areas 1-5 must meet the minimum unit requirement. Exceptions for Area 1A and Area 2A if qtr. unit courses are in a sequence.

Area 5: Physical & Biological Sciences (minimum of 7 semester units): Select one Physical and one Biological Science; one of these courses must have a laboratory and the units from both sciences must total at least 7 semester units. Minimum lecture course units: 3 sem/4 qtr. Laboratory sciences are marked +.

Physical Science (3-5 units)—select one of the following: Astronomy 3, 4, 7, +8A; Chemistry +1A, +1B, 3, +3L (+2), +5, +10, 12A, +12AL, 12B, +12BL; Engineering 3; Environmental Science 10, +10L, 15, +15L; Geography 1, +1L, 3 +3L (Meteo 1, +1L); Geology +10, 15, +20; Oceanography +10; Physics +2A, +2B, +4A, +4B, +4C, 4D, 10, +10L, +11, 12

Biological Science (3-5 units)—select from the following: Anthropology 1, 1H, +1L; Biology +4, +5, +6, +9A, +9B, +11A, +11B, +11C, 13A, +13AL, 31; Psychology 4, +4L

Foreign Language Requirement (1 course if not met in high school—UC only)

Proficiency equivalent to two years of high school study of the same foreign language or one semester of college study of a foreign language is required. Foreign Language courses taken in high school may not be counted under AREA 3—Humanities. The following languages are offered at Cabrillo College: American Sign Language, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Spanish

*****Multicultural Requirement (3 units) –AA requirement only*** (not required for the AA-T/AS-T degrees)**

One course must be taken in Multicultural Studies. Select a course from any area, which is marked # or WS 5. If the course is listed within one of the general education areas on this form, one course may double-count for both the multicultural studies requirement and for one of the above requirements.

This worksheet can be used for the following degrees:

- **AA degree in Liberal Arts and Sciences:** for students entering Cabrillo College beginning F'08, the Liberal Arts and Sciences degree requires an 18-unit emphasis. Beginning F'14, this emphasis is limited to Interdisciplinary Studies -- 6 courses from a combination of Areas A, B4, C & D on the CSU GE list. The complete list of approved courses for this area of emphasis is listed in the current Cabrillo catalog under Liberal Arts & Sciences.
- **AA degree in a specific discipline:** 18 units are required using ASSIST as a guide.
- **AS degrees in Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, General Science, Geology, Mathematics or Physics:** 30-39 units are required using the catalog model program or the transfer requirements on ASSIST as a guide.

Courses may be used to satisfy both the major/emphasis and general education requirements, but will be counted only once for the total degree units.

***For students beginning F'10, all courses in the major or emphasis must be completed with a "C" or better.**
 Completion of 27 units of G.E. also qualifies you to receive a Certificate of Completion in IGETC General Education.
 Please note: Only 4 units of ATH & KIN activity and 8 units of ATH theory courses may be counted toward the 60-unit requirement for students transferring to a UC.

Some AP and IB scores may be used for IGETC; CLEP scores *may not* be used. See a Counselor.

Use of units from other community colleges must be checked on ASSIST www.assist.org.
 A Cabrillo College counselor must check use of units from out of state or 4-year universities.

Partial certification is now allowed for University of California. Students are urged to check with UC transfer campus as some campuses (Berkeley in particular) have said that they will not allow partial IGETC.

Full Certification is required for the AA-T and AS-T degrees.
