Requirements for the CSU GE AA degree in Business for transfer to CSUMB in Business Administration (2.0 GPA required):	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 60 CSU transferable units. Use of units from other community colleges must be checked on ASSIST www.assist.org. A Cabrillo College counselor must check use of units from out of state or 4-year universities; 2. General Education-Complete at least 30 units of general education including all of Area A and Area B4. It is advisable to complete all 39 units of lower division general education before transfer. Students who complete only 30 units of G.E. before transfer will need to complete at least 9 additional <u>lower</u> division GE units at the 4-year university. All students will have at least 9 units of <u>upper</u> division GE units to complete after transfer; All of Area A and Area B4 must be completed with "C" or better; up to two courses may be counted in both the major and in general education but will only be counted once for the total degree units. 3. Complete one multicultural course; this course is not required for transfer but is required to complete the degree. 4. Major—the following Business courses are required for this degree and comprise the lower division major preparation for transfer to CSU Monterey Bay in Business Administration: <div style="margin-left: 40px;">Economics *1A & 1B, Accounting 1A & 1B, Math 12 or Business 9, Business 18 and Math *4</div> <div style="margin-left: 80px;">*may also be used to fulfill general education requirements</div> 5. Additional requirements for graduation from CSUMB <u>Foreign Language</u>—Students graduating from CSUMB are required to have competence in a second language. Although foreign language is not an admission requirement, we highly recommend completion of level 3 or higher of any foreign language, e.g. Span 3 at Cabrillo before transfer. Foreign language courses can be used to fulfill Area C2 of the general education requirements. <u>Community Participation</u>—All students must fulfill upper division service learning and possibly lower division service learning requirements within the major.

(Note: all of these math courses have a prerequisite of intermediate algebra).

NOTE: English 1B may be counted under C2 if not used to meet the A3 requirement (only through Su 05). English 1BMC may be counted only under C2. History 4A and 4B may be counted under Area C OR Area D, but not both. Students who completed the following courses Fall 1995 or earlier will receive general education credit in Area C1: Art 2A, 4, 5, 7A, 8A, 9A, 24; Music 17A, 19, 33A, 34, 35, 36, 38, 40, 46, 49, 51A, 54, 55, 58; Theatre Arts 28, 29. A maximum of six semester units in performance courses is allowed. History 4A & 4B can be used in either Area C or D, but not both.

AREA D: SOCIAL & BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (9 UNITS)

Select three courses from the following. No more than two courses may be counted from any single department. It is recommended that courses in three departments be taken to insure breadth.
