Landscape Architecture only accepts applications of the fall and winter quarters

Admission of transfer applicants to this major is competitive

*Courses **bolded** are required for minimum point consideration and must be completed by the term of transfer to Cal Poly or you will receive deficit points within the selection process. Fall quarter applicants must complete units by the preceding Spring term, not Summer.*

(English, Critical Thinking, Speech, Math) must be completed with a grade of C or better, by the term of transfer “ and must be completed (for Fall applicants) by Spring, not summer.

Unfortunately, Cabrillo doesn't offer all the courses required for the lower-division major prep. in architecture at Cal Poly. Below are recommended options to fulfill the lower division major preparation requirements for this major. Info. current as of October, 2003.
