### *New Look*

When you view the articulation on ASSIST you'll find that we've:

- re-formatted the agreements to make them more user-friendly (we hope!);

In future we will:

- eliminate from ASSIST the courses which are described as being "under review" or "denied." So we will list only community college courses which are approved for articulation with Berkeley courses.

**Integrative Biology**, MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS, the equivalent of:

- BIOLOGY 1A, BIOLOGY 1AL and BIOLOGY 1B
- CHEMISTRY 1A and CHEMISTRY 1B
- CHEMISTRY 3A, 3B, 3BL (or 112A and 112B)  
*strongly recommended* for admission in fall 07  
*required* for admission in fall 08
- MATH 16A (prerequisite to the Physics requirement)
- PHYSICS 8A (must be calculus-based physics with lab)
- PHYSICS 8B  
*strongly recommended* for admission in fall 07  
*required* for admission in fall 08

### **Microbial Biology**

Mathematics requirement for Microbial Biology may be satisfied with either

- MATH 16A and MATH 16B, or MATH 1A and MATH 1B

**Molecular and Cell Biology**, MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS, the equivalent of:

- BIOLOGY 1A, BIOLOGY 1AL and BIOLOGY 1B
- CHEMISTRY 1A and CHEMISTRY 1B
- CHEMISTRY 3A, 3B, 3BL (or 112A and 112B)
- MATH 1A and MATH 1B
- *strongly recommended*: PHYSICS 8A and PHYSICS 8B or  
PHYSICS 7A and PHYSICS 7B

### **Molecular Environmental Biology**

- Requires core course work in ESPM Environmental Science Core and Social Science Core; may be completed at Berkeley if approved courses aren't available at community college.
- Statistics is no longer required for the major in Molecular Environmental Biology.

### **Psychology**

- MATH 54 or MATH 55 have been added as courses that may satisfy the Quantitative requirement

### **Slavic Languages and Literatures**

- Major tracks include Russian Language and Literature; Czech, Polish, BCS (Bosnian, Croatian, Serbian) Language and Literature; Russian/East European/Eurasian Cultures.
