Hello Eva,

In order for students to receive credit for CSUMB's language requirement they must receive a *four* on the AP Language test (i.e. AP Spanish Language) if they are transferring with a minimum of 56 units or into what is considered one of our high unit majors (Business, Environmental Science Technology and Policy, Biology, or Liberal Studies). If students transfer with fewer than 56 units and are not in one of the high unit majors as listed then they would be required to receive a *five* on the AP Language test. A three or better will give them credits towards area C2 of GE or what CSUMB refers to as the Literature and Popular Culture ULR. Students should submit their results from the College Board to the University directly. The University cannot give credit for the Language requirement based simply on High School Transcripts. I hope this helps clarify.
