Hi, folks.

I am sending you, by attachment, a copy of the letter from Susan Wilbur, UC Director of Undergraduate Admissions, giving advice on how undocumented applicants should complete the application for admission. Note that the letter never refers to these students directly. The intent of the letter, however, is to assist undocumented students, including AB 540 students, in working through questions on the application that deal with residency.

I want to highlight one item. Students must respond to the Country of Citizenship item. One of the responses to this item is "No Selection." That choice now is the first one on the drop-down menu for the item.

I hope this information is useful to you and to others you think should have it.
