<b>Requirements for the CSU GE AA degree (2.0 GPA required):</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>60 CSU transferable units.</b> Use of units from other community colleges must be checked on ASSIST <a href="http://www.assist.org">www.assist.org</a>. A Cabrillo College counselor must check use of units from out of state or 4-year universities.</li> <li>2. <b>General Education</b> Complete at least 30 units of general education including all of Area A and Area B4. It is advisable to complete all 39 units of lower division general education before transfer. Students who complete only 30 units of G.E. before transfer will need to complete at least 9 additional <u>lower</u> division GE units at the 4-year university. All students will have at least 9 units of <u>upper</u> division GE units to complete after transfer; All of Area A and Area B4 must be completed with "C" or better; up to two courses may be counted in both the major and in general education but will only be counted once for the total degree units. <b>Completion of 30 units of G.E. also qualifies you to receive a Certificate of Achievement in General Education – ask your counselor how to petition for this Certificate.</b></li> <li>3. <b>Multicultural course</b> Complete one multicultural course; this course is not required for transfer but is required to complete the degree.</li> <li>4. <b>Major</b> This degree is in Liberal Arts and Sciences unless otherwise noted. For students entering Cabrillo College beginning F08, the Liberal Arts and Sciences degree requires an 18 unit emphasis in one of the following areas: Arts and Humanities, Social Sciences or Interdisciplinary Studies. The major course lists for this major as well as other specific majors are listed in the Cabrillo College catalog under each department. Up to two courses may be counted in both the major and in general education but will only be counted once for the total degree units. For majors other than the Liberal Arts and Sciences with emphases, the model programs found in the catalog are intended only for the AA degree at Cabrillo. Students transferring to CSU should complete the lower division major preparation courses required by the 4-year school for their chosen major for their BA or BS degree. It is advisable to work with a Cabrillo College counselor and/or consult <a href="http://www.assist.org">www.assist.org</a> for major preparation courses required or recommended before transfer.  Catalogs from 4-year universities and/or computers to do research are available in the Transfer Center.</li> </ol>
