I'm proud to announce that Azusa Pacific now accepts a completed CSU GE Breadth certificate as meeting our general studies requirements with the following provisions:

- Students must still satisfy the foreign language requirement
- Students must still satisfy the Health Education and Fitness for Life requirements
- Students must still take the requisite number of biblical studies courses
- Students must still take the requisite number of upper division electives

Also as a reminder, we do accept a completed IGETC certificate as meeting general studies requirements with the following provisions:

- Students must still satisfy the foreign language requirement
- Students must still satisfy the Health Education and Fitness for Life requirements
- Students must still satisfy the math requirement (College Algebra minimum)
- Students must still take the requisite number of biblical studies courses
- Students must still take the requisite number of upper division electives

In the case of both the CSU GE Breadth and IGETC, the certificate must be complete, and the certificate must be obtained from the respective community college before the student matriculates to APU. Students who do not receive certification of completion will be subject to standard course-to-course articulation and must follow the APU General Studies program.

Students do not need to complete a minimum number of units before transferring. They can transfer at any time. APU gives credit for no more than 70 units of junior or two-year college work and the maximum amount of transferable units is 90 (including work from a four-year institution).
