Thank you for your interest in Santa Clara University! This guide has been designed to help make the course-planning process easier for students who wish to transfer into the College of Arts & Sciences at SCU.

Prospective transfer students and students planning to enter SCU at the freshman level please note the following prior to using this document:

- This guide represents the core (general education) curriculum Santa Clara University had in place for incoming freshmen students through Fall 2008. As of Fall 2009, SCU introduced a new core curriculum and consequently has designed new guides to assist transfer students with planning. *Students planning to transfer into SCU for Fall 2010* as a sophomore or a junior may still utilize the guide found on the following pages. *Students planning to transfer in Fall 2011 and later* need to refer to the guide designed for SCU's new core curriculum and should not use the document below for planning purposes.
- This guide is designed for **transfer students only**. Students who plan on entering SCU as a freshman and would like to utilize this guide to help select courses that will transfer to satisfy core requirements will need to note the following:  
1) students may not take courses to satisfy their Critical Thinking and Writing *or* Cultures and Ideas requirements from other schools—those requirements must be taken at Santa Clara University; 2) students can satisfy their Math, Laboratory Science, Modern Language, Diversity, Social Science, and Arts requirements at another school **PRIOR** to attending SCU. **Please note:** Once students have begun their academic careers at SCU, they may not take classes at another institution to satisfy core and/or major/minor requirements.
- Oftentimes schools will cross-list a single course separately under different departments. This guide will individually list cross-listed courses for each department they are found in. It is a student's responsibility to notice whether or not a course is cross-listed as credit will only be issued one time from SCU.
- If a student takes an honors version of a course that is listed on this guide, SCU will accept that class as transferable.
- Math courses eligible for transfer to SCU to fulfill math requirements are listed on this guide. A Pre-Calculus course is eligible to receive general elective credit but will not satisfy SCU's core math requirement.

**Bachelor of Arts Degree**

**Majors:** Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

**Admission requirements:**

- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course from the following: *Anthropology* 1/1L or 1H/1L; *Astronomy* 3/8A, 4/8A; *Biology* 1A, 1B, 1C, 4, 5, 6, 11A, 11B, 11C, 13A/13AL; *Chemistry* 1A, 1B, 2, 5, 10, 12A/L, 12B/L; *Geography* 1/L; *Geology* 10, 20; *Meteorology* 1/1L; *Oceanography* 10; *Physics* 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10/10L, 11.

**Recommended courses:**

**The following courses allow students to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum (General Education) requirements:**

- 1) **Western Culture:** Two courses from **one** of the following sequences: *Art History* 20A, 20B; *History* 4A, 4B; *History* 4AH, 4BH; *Philosophy* 6, 7.
- 2) **Math or Biological/Physical Science:** One additional course in either subject area. The science course can be taken with or without a lab. - 3) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the second semester course of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination in order to satisfy SCU's language requirement. **Students may take a language not offered at SCU (i.e. American Sign Language) to fulfill this requirement as long as they successfully complete the requirement prior to attending Santa Clara University.**
- 4) **Social Science:** One course from the following: *Anthropology* 2, 3; *Economics* 1A, 1B; *Political Science* 1, 1H, 2, 3; *Psychology* 1, 6; *Sociology* 1, 1H, 2, 2H, 3, 5; *Women's Studies* 7.

**Bachelor of Science Degree**

**Majors:** Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Sciences, Liberal Studies (pre-teaching), Mathematics, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Public Health Science, and Sociology. **Please note: Students interested in majoring in Liberal Studies, Biology or Public Health Science should refer to major-specific guides on the following pages.**

**Admission requirements:**

- 1) **English:** Two courses -- one course from 1) *English* 1A, 1AH, 1AMC, 1AMCH **and** one course from 2) *English* 1B, 1BMC, 2, 2H, 2MC, 2MCH.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Two courses -- *Math* 5A and 5B. Anthropology, Liberal Studies, Political Science, and Sociology majors can choose from *Math* 5A, 5B, 12, 13, 18 (however you **may not** take *Math* 18 with *Math* 5A or 5B). Psychology majors can choose from *Math* 5A, 5B, 13, 18.  
**Anthropology majors please note:** *Math* 12 is required for your major at SCU.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course from the following: *Anthropology* 1/1L or 1H/1L; *Astronomy* 3/8A, 4/8A; *Biology* 1A, 1B, 1C, 4, 5, 6, 11A, 11B, 11C, 13A/13AL; *Chemistry* 1A, 1B, 2, 5, 10, 12A/L, 12B/L; *Geography* 1/L; *Geology* 10, 20; *Meteorology* 1/1L; *Oceanography* 10; *Physics* 2A, 2B, 4A, 4B, 4C, 10/10L, 11.

- 2) **Mathematics:** Two courses – *Math* 5A and 5B.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course from *Chemistry* 1A, 1B.

**Recommended courses:**

**The following courses allow students to complete more of SCU's Core Curriculum (General Education)/Biology or Public Health Science requirements:**

- 1) **Statistics:** *Math* 12 (Statistics) is required for Public Health Science majors only.
- 2) **Biological Sciences:** *Biology* 1A, 1B, 1C.
- 3) **Chemistry:** *Chemistry* 1B, 12A/L, 12B/L.
- 4) **Physics:** *Physics* 2A, 2B **or** *Physics* 4A, 4B for Biology and those Public Health Science majors interested in pursuing a Pre-Med track only.
