

BOG Fee Waiver: Do You Qualify?

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS



There are new laws; read your BOG application carefully.

METHOD A: Be a recipient or a dependent of a recipient of:

- ✓ TANF/CalWORKS, SSI/SSP, or General Assistance, **or**
- ✓ Dependent's fee waiver from the Veteran's Affairs Dept., **or**
- ✓ Dependent's fee waiver from the National Guard Adjutant, **or**
- ✓ Congressional Medal of Honor, or 9-11 Dependent, **or**
- ✓ Dependent of a deceased law enforcement/fire suppression personnel killed in the line of duty.

Attach proof of benefits dated this month or last month.

Note: SSA and SSDI are NOT the same as SSI.

METHOD B: Meet the 2006 income guidelines listed below.

Attach a signed photocopy of 2006 IRS 1040 tax return.

Note: W2's are NOT the same as taxes.

| Number in family | Income limits |
|------------------|---------------|
| 1 | \$14,700 |
| 2 | \$19,800 |
| 3 | \$24,900 |
| 4 | \$30,000 |

Add \$5,100 for each additional person.

If you do not qualify under Method A or B, file a 2007-08 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Allow time for processing.

If eligible for BOG, students who have already paid their registration fees will be mailed a reimbursement by the College Bank for the current term.
