

**Registration Checklist
for Co-Enrolled High School Students**

- Submit a *Cabrillo College Application* online
 - 3-5 days prior to registering
 - Application available online at www.cabrillo.edu
 - for each semester you wish to co-enroll
- Submit a *High School Release Form*
 - available online: <http://www.cabrillo.edu/services/ar/documents/hsrelease.pdf>
 - with signatures of high school counselor, your parent, yourself and Cabrillo counselor (if you take more than 6 units)
 - with specific courses you want to take listed on form (High school students cannot take 200 level courses)
 - Remember your application will NOT be processed without a *High School Release Form*
- Take an *Assessment/Placement Test*
 - 3-5 working days after submitting the *Application* and *High School Release form*
 - If you plan to take English or math classes (including science classes requiring math)
 - If you plan to take more than 2 classes or more than 6 units
 - If you are below grade 9 (High School Release signed by HS principal and Cabrillo counselor)
 - Arrive 30 minutes early
 - Bring your Social Security Number and picture ID.

- Register during Early Registration
 - On WebAdvisor at www.cabrillo.edu
 - Pay enrollment, health, student center and student representation fee by cash, credit card, check, or Fee Waiver (Fees listed in the *Schedule of Classes*)
 - Write your Social Security Number or student ID Number and name on check
 - Mail to: College Bank, Cabrillo College, 6500 Soquel Drive, Aptos, CA 95003
 - You need to attend the first class meeting to ensure your enrollment
- Apply for a BOG Fee Waiver, if you are eligible for financial aid
 - See Income Guidelines on the Internet at: <http://www.cabrillo.edu/services/finaid> and click on "Types of Aid"
- To Register during Late Registration
 - Obtain add code from your instructor
 - Go to WebAdvisor to add a class and pay your fees
- Buy your textbooks
 - In the Cabrillo Bookstore or at <http://cabrillobooks.net/>.
 - Used books for sale 2 weeks before the semester begins - plan ahead
