BP 3010
Graduation Requirements

The District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation. Students must also complete the general education residency and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations. All courses that count toward the associate degree major or area of emphasis must be “satisfactorily completed” with grades of A, B, C or P (pass). All degree requirements, including general education, must be completed with an overall grade point average of 2.0 or better.

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Achievement upon successful completion of a minimum of 18 or more semester units of degree-applicable coursework designed as a pattern of learning experiences designed to develop certain capabilities that may be oriented to career or general education. All Certificates of Achievement require completion of an English Composition course. Skills certificates will be awarded to students who acquire a set of occupationally relevant skills through the successful completion of one or more courses as designated in the college catalog. All courses that count toward the Certificate of Achievement and skills certificates must be “satisfactorily completed” with grades of A, B, C or P (pass).
