### **Directions to Scotts Valley Center (Satellite Campus)**

**From Monterey, Salinas or Santa Cruz** - Take HWY 1 north and exit onto HWY 17 (toward San Jose and Oakland). From HWY 17 take the MT HERMON RD exit. Mount Hermon Road takes you over HWY 17 towards Scotts Valley. At the second stop light, turn left onto WHISPERING PINES DR. Turn right into first parking lot and park in a Cabrillo College parking space.

**From San Jose, Campbell, or Los Gatos** - Take HWY 17 south and take the MOUNT HERMON ROAD exit. Take a right onto MT HERMON RD. After second stop light, turn left onto WHISPERING PINES DR. Turn right into first parking lot and park in a Cabrillo College parking space.

### **Parking at the Scotts Valley Center**

Parking spaces are limited, and we ask for your cooperation in following these important guidelines:

1. During the day until 6 p.m, please avoid parking in Comcast parking spaces. After Comcast regular business hours, this restriction no longer applies. Additionally, please leave the spaces near the Comcast building available for customers at all times.
2. Please respect neighboring businesses and keep their parking spaces free for their customers. We want to remain good neighbors.
3. The City of Scotts Valley has recently added 20 parking spaces on Whispering Pines, which are available after 7:00 am and before 10:00 pm. Also, there is street parking available on Lundy Lane by Hocus Pocus Park, behind Integrity Automotive across the street. Keep in mind that there is no street lighting in the evening along these streets.
4. There are Santa Cruz Metro bus stops in the vicinity of the Kentucky Fried Chicken store on Mt. Hermon Road, just south of Whispering Pines Drive, a very short walk from the Center. Busses provide a convenient alternative to driving. Consider car pooling, too.
5. Please do not park in spaces reserved and marked for staff parking.
