## Textbooks On Reserve

If the cost of a required textbook is \$50.00 or more, a single copy of that textbook will be on Reserve at the Cabrillo Library for shared use. This innovative textbook loan program has been funded by a generous grant from the Cabrillo College Student Senate. The goal of the program is to guarantee that at least one copy of the most expensive required textbooks is on reserve at the library. ## Textbook Rental Program

The Cabrillo College Bookstore continues to add titles to the textbook rental program. The program consists of titles with the rental price set at 40% of the new book price. ## **Cabrillo partners with CHEGG (online textbook rental service)**

The Cabrillo Bookstore has four terminals at which students can access an online textbook rental service where some required books can be found at a fraction of the cost of a new (or even used) books. The company is Chegg, and it bills itself as the country's largest textbook rental service.

There are a limited number of copies available for each title, and students might not find the book they need is available. For rentals, students must sign an agreement stipulating the condition in which the book should be returned, and they must return it by a specific date or face penalties. For the online service, **students may have the books shipped to the Cabrillo**

**Bookstore for easy pickup and from the Cabrillo Bookstore for returned shipping to CHEGG.**
