1	Final Submission Date for TAA contract is:	Nov. 30, 2011
2	Submit a CSUMentor confirmation page (showing that you have applied) by:	Nov. 30, 2011
3	TAA contract will not be accepted for the following impacted majors :	NO majors impacted
4	Be a California resident. Students with F1/J1 visa and non-residents are not TAA eligible. All supporting residency documents should be attached or subject to denial.	✓
5	Will complete 30 semester/45 quarter CSU <u>General Education</u> units with “C” grades or better by the end of:	Summer 2011
6	Will complete 60 semester/90 quarter <u>transferable</u> units with a 2.00 GPA or better by the end of:	Spring 2012
7	Will complete with a “C” or better ALL four basic skills courses listed on contract by the end of:	Spring 2012
8	\$55 application fee may be waived according to campus. If so, on CSUMENTOR make sure you designate that you will be paying by check, but do not send check . Campus will clear your fee once the contract is approved and processed. If you pay, no refunds will be given!	WAIVED
9	Do not have a bachelor’s degree.	✓
10	Will complete all post-secondary course work in the U.S.	✓
11	Have never attended as a regularly matriculated student at the campus to which you are applying. Open University/Continuing Education is acceptable.	✓
12	Have NOT/will NOT apply for admission for Spring 2012. If considering, don’t apply for Fall 2012 under TAA. Apply through regular admission.	✓
13	Are in good standing at the last college or university attended, i.e., you are eligible to re-enroll.	✓
14	Will submit official AP scores (if applicable) and official transcript(s) from all previously attended college(s) and current college(s) by:	Feb. 15 th 2012
15	Official transcripts are due by February 15 th 2011. (Does not need to include fall grades). All other transcripts from institutions already attended must also be submitted as official.	Feb. 15 th 2012
16	Will submit official final transcript(s) with Spring 2011 grades by: (Students taking summer classes still need to submit a transcript by July 8 th 2011)	July 8 th , 2012
17	If any of the 4-basic skills courses were completed outside of the CCC, a GE Certification is required	Not required But recommended
