Humboldt State University guarantees to admit you as an upper division transfer in the term noted above provided you complete the following requirements by no later than the term preceding HSU entry:

- Complete a minimum of 60 transferable semester units with an overall grade point average of 2.00 or better (2.40 for nonresidents) and remain in good standing.
- Complete at least 30 units of general education which must include all four CSU general education basic subjects courses with grades of C– or higher in Written Communication, Oral Communication, Mathematical Concepts and Critical Thinking* (see table below) **OR** complete the IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum). Fall applicants must complete both their English and Math GE courses before summer begins.
- Submit a complete CSU Application for Admission while the campus is still accepting applications for the term listed above. Apply on the web at www.csumentor.edu.
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended for verification of eligibility requirements.
*Critical Thinking is waived for declared Environmental Resources Engineering majors.

Please note that the maximum number of units that may be transferred from community colleges to the CSU is 70. It is strongly recommended that you complete the lower division preparation for the major. However, it is not a requirement for admission. For information about lower division major coursework, see www.assist.org.

This agreement is valid only for the term checked above. If a later term of entry is desired, a new agreement must be completed. The TAG agreement may not be written for more than two (2) years in advance of the transfer term. This agreement does not bind HSU if the information provided is incomplete or inaccurate.
