

Remote Login using PuTTY 0.52

PuTTY is a freeware Telnet program that supports the SSH standard. PuTTY is installed in the CTC lab, in the classroom and is easily downloadable and installable on a windows pc.

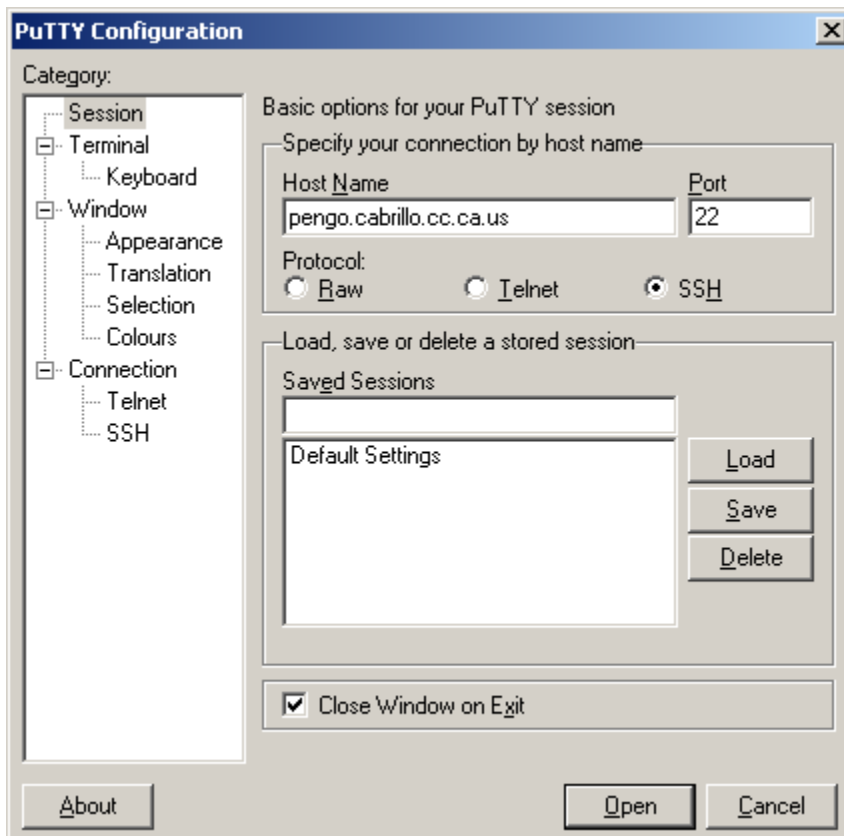


Figure 1 (Putty v0.51 Screenshot)

When you start PuTTY, you are taken to the configuration screen (see Figure 1)
You need to

1. Type in the Host Name: **pengo.cabrillo.cc.ca.us**
2. Set the Protocol to: **SSH**
3. Optional: set any preferences such as font size or color
4. Click ok

You will be prompted for your login name and then your password. Pengo accounts will be given out the first day of class - after that they may be obtained via email.

After you are connected, you may access configuration options by right-clicking on the title bar. Selected text is placed on the clipboard automatically.
