[The Child Development Training Consortium](#) (CDTC) is a program funded by the California Department of Education, Child Development Division (CDE/CDD) with Federal Block Grant Child Care and Development Quality Improvement Funds. The program is administered through the Yosemite Community College District.

ECE Student Career and Education Program

Are you working with children and families and taking classes at Cabrillo College? You may be eligible for a stipend that will pay for part of your tuition as an ECE major!

- Students must reapply for this stipend each semester.
- Students can collect the stipend if they are on financial aid or are participating in another grant program.
- This stipend does not affect those awards.

Program eligibility:

As an ECE Major you may qualify for a special stipend to help pay for all classes that lead to your ECE A.S. degree through the Child Development Training Consortium (CDTC).

Eligible students must be working in a licensed child care center, after school program, family child care home, kindergarten, or transitional kindergarten to receive the stipend.

Stipends are based on how many units a student completes. ALL units that count toward a degree, certificate, or teaching credential are eligible, including ECE, ESL and General Ed classes. This semester, the awards will be:

*2-3.5 units=\$50, 4-7.5 units=\$100,
8-11.5 units=\$150, 12 units and up=\$180*

The application is completed online in either Spanish or English. Paper applications are also available (please contact Michelle Chao at michao@cabrillo.edu for details).

CHECKLIST FOR ONLINE APPLICATION

- **Completing** the application and submitting online
- **Printing** your application
- Applicants must **sign and date** the first page of their application
- Your **supervisor must sign, date and list the license number** of the facility if applicable
- Attach a **copy of your class schedule** for all classes taken in **spring 2019**
- Submit your completed application to the ECE office by **April 5, 2019**

Child Development Permits

The CDTC has two sources of funding, CDE/CDD and First 5 California, to pay application and fingerprint (LiveScan) processing fees for Child Development Permit applicants. Each funding source has different eligibility criteria and levels of permits funded.

Applications are processed on a first come, first served basis. Funding is limited.
