

MULTICULTURAL STUDIES REQUIREMENT

Goal: To promote critical thinking and enrich students' understanding of cultural diversity by studying under-represented ethnic and racial groups in the country of their origin or in the United States.

Students will be able to:

- a) Analyze their own attitudes, behaviors, and beliefs regarding diversity and bias
- b) Demonstrate an appreciation for diversity and multiculturalism, one that allows for the development of skills leading to effective communication and satisfactory social relations
- c) Recognize the historical experiences of ethnic and racial groups in the United States who have been targets of individual and institutional racism and classism
- d) Recognize the contributions to American society and culture made by ethnic groups who have suffered discrimination and exclusion
- e) Explore the development of group and individual identity within unequal power relations while addressing the unique historical and contemporary responses from within each group.
