

**Honors Transfer Program – Application Timelines and Process
For High School Seniors
(Complete 1, 2 and 3)**

1. Apply to Cabrillo College for Fall, 2017 Admission –
Applications open in October, 2016 - apply to Cabrillo on-line at <http://www.cabrillo.edu/services/ar/>

2. Apply to the Honors Transfer Program for Fall, 2017- requires a *separate and additional on-line application* – you must also apply to *Enroll at Cabrillo College* (see #1. above)
Application window is February 1st, 2017 to April 15th, 2017
 - On-line application at <http://go.cabrillo.edu/honors> , to include the
 - Essay – 250 words – in response to one of two prompts – see on-line application
 - One Letter of Recommendation –mail to the address below
 - **Official High School Transcript** to include Fall, 2016 grades – minimum weighted H.S. GPA of 3.5 in a-g requirements; **or** SAT (new) total of at least 1400 (1900 on the old SAT); or Enhanced ACT composite of 29+ - mail to address below. (Note: SAT or ACT scores *are not* admissible for Assessment/Placement into Cabrillo English or Math classes).
 - **College-level English readiness demonstrated by:**
 - CAASPP EAP taken junior year of high school test resulting score: **2682 and above** (waves assessment and places into ENGL 1A) **or**
 - Advance Placement (AP) English Language or Literature test with a minimum score of 3 (4 preferred) –mail your AP transcript/scores to address below (Note: a student admitted to the Honors program with a score of 3 in AP Eng/Lang or AP Eng/Comp will receive a recommendation to take Cabrillo’s Honors College Composition course (ENGL 1AH))

or

 - Cabrillo English Assessment results – students must assess *into* ENGL 1A.

All of the above must be received before eligibility for the program can be determined. Meeting minimum qualifications does not guarantee admission to the program.

3. Running Start Early Registration (for Santa Cruz County High School students only) –
You should participate in Running Start, and as long as you indicate your Santa Cruz area high school correctly on the CCC Apply application, and that you are a “new college student”, Cabrillo will notify you about other Running Start information you need during the Spring semester. **Running Start registration date is May 19, 2017.**

In order to benefit from Running Start Early Registration, the Application to Enroll at Cabrillo, Assessment, Orientation and completion of an Education Plan Workshop **MUST** all be completed by **April 15th** ; Honors Application deadline is also April 15th.
